Dear Organizer, Thank you for considering Laser-Tag.com.au for your fete or festival hire.

Laser Tag is a fun and exciting idea for your event.

Here you will find all the Laser-tag.com.au information you need to choose us for your event hire. With Laser tag you can get real, get inventive and get everyone

talking about you for weeks after your event. Laser Tag is **Ready, Aim...Fun!** Laser tag can be set up on a grassed area such as your showgrounds; or in an indoor area like a gymnasium.

We deliver you 10 Gaming Guns, 2 Referee Guns, 10 Headbands—5 of each colour (the idea is that these go over the player's own hat), 2 keys and a large banner.

We also include simple to follow



Gaming guns

Our gaming equipment uses harmless infrared – just like your TV remote; but bigger! When you pull the trigger you get great light and sound effects. Every gaming gun comes with integrated sensors so you can play either indoors or outdoors. Plus every one has a cool red dot scope for sighting. The gaming guns have ammo limits so when you run out, players just press the left button once to re-load. It takes around 6 seconds. Then they are back in action! When they arrive the guns are set at 5 "lives". The first four times they are tagged the gun makes a "ough!" sound, then on the final hit their gun make a "aaarrgh!" sound effect and turns itself off. Players return to their starting position and the referee shoots them with a Referee Gun to re-start them.



Hints & Tips for the best battlefield!

Set the theme with a cool playing area. We suggest hay-bales or painted cardboard boxes. You can weight down the boxes using old 2lt milk bottles filled with water.

But we've found it is best to use a treed area, often found near your oval or on the edge of your show-grounds.

You can also hire our Camo Nets for only \$15 per hire.

When promoting the event, we think it is a fun idea to use a 24 hour clock eg, games start at 1300 hours or Oh-800.

If you have time, why not hit the army disposal or surplus stores for tarps, ammo boxes or other military themed things. We also have dog tag available to purchase – they are \$5 each and include a long

chain. Likewise we have camo scrim net available for you to sell to your players. They retail at \$12 each, but if you buy 100 or 250 or more then it's 25% off.

This is a idea to add to your event fundraising.

instructions on how to run the games. These short fun games often only last 5 to 7 minutes each. But to the player it feels like a lot longer because it is so exciting!

BONUS: Hire them for Saturday and get Sunday for free.

Booking Procedure

Complete the booking form on the next page. Once you have filled it in, and signed it, fax it to us on 1300 666 549.

1. When we receive your booking form we will call you to confirm the dates you have booked. If the weekend you want is booked out, we will try to re-schedule for you.

2. Once your date is confirmed, your booking needs to be secured by paying a 50% deposit. Once we have received your deposit your booking is locked in.
3. Pay the remaining amount 7 days prior to your booking date. All funds will need to be paid before your box is shipped.

Running Games is Simple

Run simple elimination games. Divide the group into roughly equal team sizes. Then let loose the bravo team versus the delta team. Each time one of the gamers loses all their "lives" they go back to their start point and get re-started with the Referee Gun.

The team which has the least number of re-starts at the end is the winner.

Safety is IMPORTANT
As the person hiring the gear it is your responsibility to supervise the players. We recommend letting everyone know at the start that this is a non-contact sport.

We recommend enforcing that there is no moving or jumping over your barricades.
